The Pearl E. Pauker Prize in Writing

The *Pearl E. Pauker Prize in Writing* and its companion, the *Pearl E. Pauker Prize in Science*, awarded this year for the second time, were established by Dr. Robert Pauker to encourage and recognize academic excellence in the work of *Lake Forest College* undergraduates, and to honor the memory of his mother. The *Pearl E. Pauker Prize in Writing* is intended "to encourage and recognize writing that demonstrates grace, eloquence, clarity, and thoughtfulness," and selection criteria stipulate that the student whose paper wins the first prize in the annual *Lake Forest College Writing Contest* shall be the recipient of the prize each year. The prize confers special academic distinction, a prize certificate, and a stipend to aid recipients in the further pursuit of their studies.
